



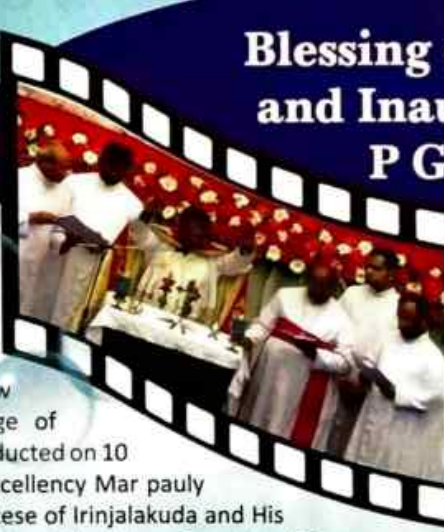
Message

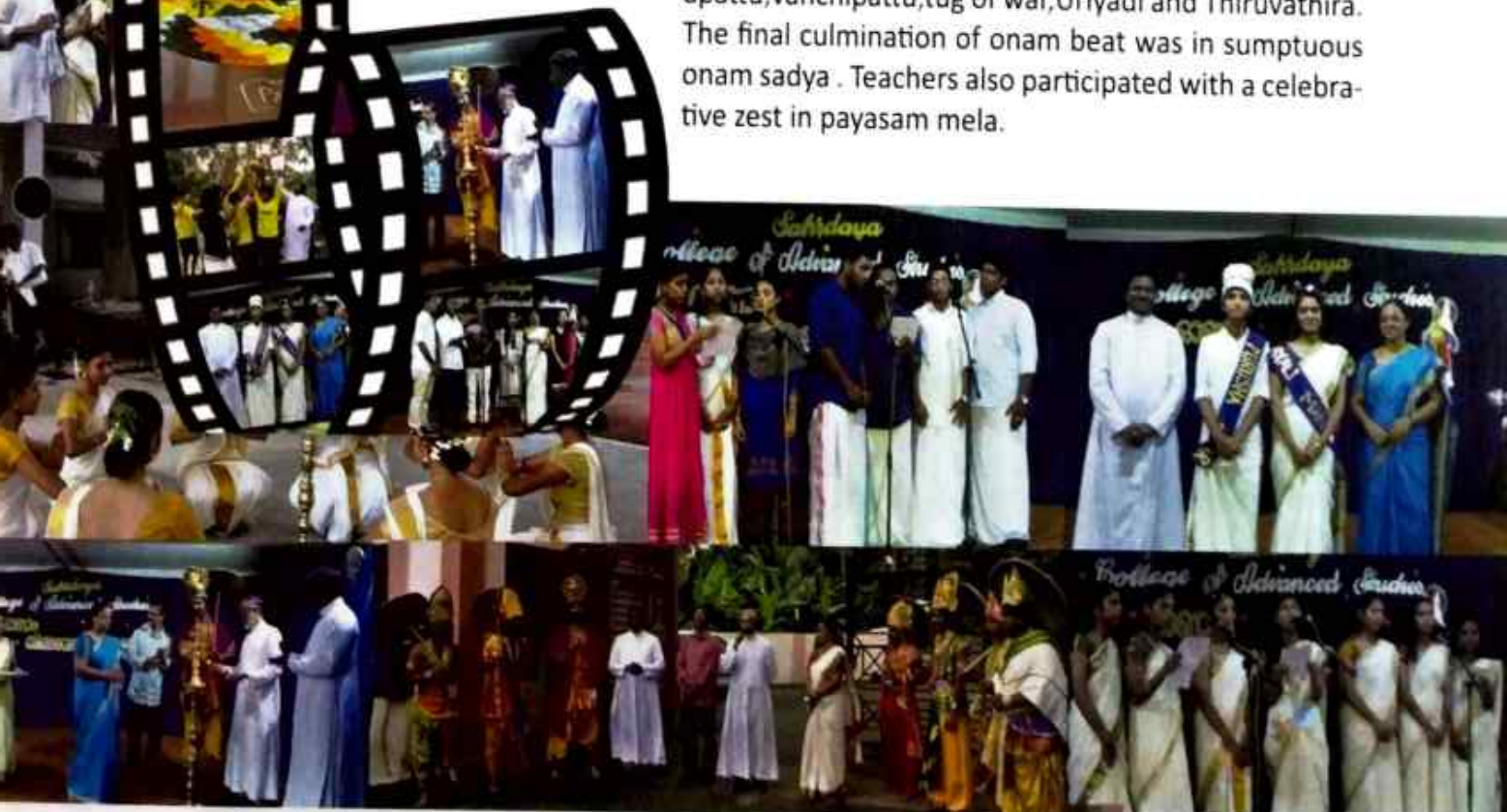

Proficiency

There is a lot of hue and cry from outside educational institutions especially from parents and from those who are desirous of quality in education that we terribly lag behind in English proficiency. This is true. The very awareness of it is our guardian angel that we pace forward to its reality. Various effective even more efforts are made on the part of academic community towards this end, whether it be with a clear motive of competitiveness or otherwise is matter irrelevant in this context. The pertinent question is whether we win on this front remarkably to boast of.



It is good to know a few handicaps of why we fail in it at various degrees depending upon here in our college or elsewhere. The miracle of mother tongue and its effectiveness need not mention. Linguists would unanimously assert that the best and only method of acquisition of language is by imitation. With no such tangles a child acquires language and uses it in his different stages of life with greater confidence. Its credit goes to the very method of acquisition. This is not possible in the case of a foreign tongue. When we speak of our mother tongue, Malayalam we cannot fail to admit that it is evenly stressed language differently from Tamil which is a drawback in the context of English language proficiency. It is highly laudable that universities initiate steps to rectify it in the form of introducing basics and the like in the curriculum. Class strengths is yet another hurdle which is also widely discussed. If any move is launched to introduce optimum strength, efficacy could be thought to be at the doorstep. Many pronged programmes and intensifying efforts and monitoring whether our goals are achieved are some humble steps in this regard. Methods are very many but this being an editorial I limit to the minimum. This is to provoke and conscientize and not to elaborate. If these few words strike your imagination, the speaker is more than satisfied on the line English proficiency.
