1. Admission

1.1 General Norms:

- Except in the allocation of seats required by the Government (50% Merit), the Management reserves the right for the remaining seats to fix the criteria for admission from time to time.
- Due credit will be given to the locals, staff recommended, students' relatives, differently ungabled and reserved classes.
- Weight age will be given to those who have fared in cultural, sports and literary activities State level.
- Credits are given to NSS, NCC and other similar categories on remarkable performance.

1.2 Eligibility Norms:

1.2.1. B.Sc. Psychology

Candidates who have passed* the Higher Secondary Examination (HSE) or an equivalent examination.

1.2.2. B.Sc. Computer Science

 Candidates who have passed* the HSE or any equivalent examination with Mathematics/Statistics/ Computer Science/ Computer Application etc. as one of the subjects.

1.2.3. B.C.A.

 Candidates who have passed* the HSE or any other equivalent examination with Mathematics/ComputerScience/ Computer Application / Informatics Practices as one of the subjects.

1.2.4. B.Sc. Mathematics

 Candidates who have passed* the HSE or any other equivalent examination with Maths group are eligable. Candidates who have studied Mathematics /Computer Application/ Statistics atc. with other combinations at HSE leval are also eligible for mission

1.2.5. B.Com.(Finance/Banking/Computer Application)

 Candidates who have passed* the HSE or its equivalent, with at least one Commerce subject. Candidates who have not taken at least one Commerce subject for HSE or an equivalent examination should get at least 24 GPV (in 6 subjects) in the examination concerned.

1.2.6. B.B.A.

 Any candidate who has passed* the HSE or its equivalent, with not less than 27GPV. A concession of 3 GPV will be given to OBC/OEC candidates. The SC/ST candidates need only a pass*.

1.2.7. B.A. English

 Candidates who have passed* the HSE or an equivalent Examination.

2. Admission Regulations

- 2.1 Application for admission is to be made in the prescribed form available from the College office on payment of Rs. 150/-. In all future correspondence, quote your Application number. Registration of an application does not guarantee admission.
- 2.2 Application forms should be legibly filled in and completed in all respects. Make sure that no column is left blank.
- 2.3 Write your name and address (with PIN) only in capital letters.
- 2.4 Filled in applications should reach the College on or before the last date fixed for the receipt of applications. Postal delays will not be attended to.
- 2.5 Selection of the candidates for admission will be as per the Government norms, University rules and other criteria.
- 2.6 Intimation cards will be sent and their details will be on the notice board and the college website. The applicants are required to be in touch with the College office for the information regarding interview and admission. The Intimation Card does not guarantee admission. The college will not be responsible for the late or non-receipt of Intimation Card.
- 2.7 All selections are subject to the approval of the Management Council. Candidates who fail to report will have to face the follow up.
- 2.8 At the time of interview the applicant should be accompanied by his / her parent and produce the relevant documents required.
- 2.9 If eligible for either concession or admission, Caste or Income Certificate, whichever relevant, is to be produced.
- 2.10 The selected candidates will be admitted on paying the prescribed fees and producing the original certificates. Candidates are advised to have with them sufficient number of attested copies of the certificates. The originals will be returned to the students only after the completion of the course or on issuing the Transfer Certificate.
- 2.11 Fee once paid will not be refunded after the expiry of the closure of admission stipulated by the University. If cancellation is made on demand by the student within the period stipulated by the University, a reasonable fee will be charged.

ANNUAL REPORT (2016-17)

Unlike hard skills, which comprise a person's technical skill set and ability to perform certain functional tasks, soft skills are interpersonal and broadly applicable across job titles and industries. Many soft skills are tied to individuals' personalities rather than any formal training, and are thus considered more difficult to develop than hard skills. Soft skills are often described in terms of personality traits, such as optimism, integrity and a sense of humor. These skills are also defined by abilities that can be practiced, such as leadership, empathy, communication and sociability.

In soft skills training, various topics like personal and interpersonal skills, etiquettes, body language, emotional intelligence, self-exploration and ten life skills introduced by WHO, were taught.
