

Indirect grading system, based on a 7 – point scale is used to evaluate the performance of students. Each course is evaluated by assigning marks with a letter grade (A+, A, B, C, D, E or F). Seven point indirect grading system A Minimum of 40% with E grade is required for a pass The indirect grading system will be as follows:-Indirect grading system:

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Grade Card

The University under its seal shall issue a grade card to the students on completion of each semester. The final Grade Card issued at the end of the final semester shall contain the details of all courses taken during the entire programme including the CGPA of common courses, core courses, complementary courses and open courses. This is done on a seven point scale.

Award of Degree

Successful completion of all the courses prescribed for the degree programme with C grade shall be the minimum requirement for the award of the degree.

ADMISSION

Regulations

- 1. Application for admission is to be made in the prescribed form available from the College office on payment of UG Rs.250, PG-Rs. 500/-. In all future correspondence, quote your Application number. Registration of an application does not guarantee admission.
- 2. Application forms should be legibly filled in and complete in all respects. Make sure that no column is left blank.
- 3. Write your name and address (with PIN) only in capital letters.
- 4. Filled in applications should reach the College on or before the last date fixed for the receipt of applications. Postal delays will not be attended to.
- 5. Selection of the candidates for admission will be as per the Government norms, University rules and other criteria (50% on Merit and 50% by Management).
- 6. Intimation cards will be sent and their details will be available on the college notice board and the College website. The applicants are required to be in touch with the College office for the information regarding interview and admission. The Intimation Card does not guarantee admission. The college will not be responsible for the late non-receipt of Intimation Card.
- 7. All selections are subject to the approval of the Management Council. Candidates who fail to report will have to face the follow up.
- 8. At the time of interview the applicant should be accompanied by his / her parent and produce the relevant documents.
- 9. If eligible for either concession or admission, Caste or Income Certificate, which ever relevant, is to be produced.
- 10. The selected candidates will be admitted on payment the prescribed fees and production of the original certificates. Candidates are advised to have with them sufficient number of copies of the certificates with them. The originals will be returned to the students only after the completion of the course and also after producing no due certificate from the concerned

departments. CAP ID (Centralized admission Process) on line registration with university of Calicut is mandatory.

11. Fee once paid will not be refunded after the closure of admission process stipulated by the University. If cancellation is made on demand by the student within the period stipulated by the University, a reasonable fee will be charged.

Admission to the subsequent academic years

- □ Admissions begin on third week of May every year.
- □ Classes for all the courses will begin during the first week of July.
- □ Students are requested to obey the rules and regulations of the college.
- □ Admission is made for one academic year only.
- Students who are irregular or who do not perform well in the examinations, and those whose conduct and behaviour are not up to the mark will not be admitted to the subsequent academic year(s) of study.
- □ For any and for all payments, a receipt shall be obtained from the office. It is the duty of the student to collect them and keep them safe till the completion of the course.

Discipline and Rules of conduct

- 1. Students shall compulsorily wear the prescribed college Uniform on all the prescribed days. Uniform symbolises unity and uniformity with a special identity. It also indicates equality and a sense of belonging to the institution. Hence it is a source of pride and responsibility, not liability.
- 2. Parents are to see that the uniform other attires and hairstyle of their wards are in tune with modesty and dignity that every sahrdayan shall possess.
- 3. Students should make sure of wearing at all time college identification cards which is highly necessary with in the college premises. Wearing I.D. Card for staff members and students is mandatory on the campus
- 4. Ragging is banned on the college campus. Anyone found guilty of ragging and / or abetting ragging is liable to be punished as per the directive of the UGC and Government orders and judgements of Courts of Law in this regard. Any incident of ragging with be dealt with seriously. The accused wil be dismissed from the college and a case will be filed with the local police authorities.
- 5. The college prohibits political activities on the campus and forbids students from conducting and attending political meeting within the college campus.
- 6. Boards, flags, banners or any other articles meant for political activity must not be brought or kept in the campus. Such articles, if any, will be removed from the college premises.
- 7. Students are not allowed to make mass complaints or present any collective petition.
- As per the Govt. order No. Rt/ No. 346/05/Higher Edn. dt. 1-3-2005 students are not allowed to use mobile phone on the campus; otherwise the mobile phone will be confiscated. The

use of all kinds of cameras, including mobile phone cameras, is strictly prohibited with in the campus.

- 9. Students shall not use the emblem / photo of the college in transaction of the social media (Facebook, Whatsapp etc) Students are strictly advised not to participate in any discussions, trolling or any such or other kinds of activities detrimental to the reputation of the college, departments, staff and students. If any such activities come to the notice of the college, the authorities shall initiate appropriate legal action against such individuals or groups under the provisions of cyber crime Act. The principal reserves the right to refuse admission to any applicant for any programme without assigning any reason, if he or she feels that admission of that person is detrimental to the interest and discipline of the college.
- 10. In the interest of the institution and for the sake of discipline, the college is entitled to take any punitive action on any student for his/her misconduct.

Misconduct shall include:

- a) Staying away from classes without sufficient reason.
- b) Disrespectful behaviour towards the staff and fellow students.
- c) Loitering in the verandas during free hours and creating disturbance to the classes in progress. (During free hours the students are expected to make use of Biblioteca)
- d) Disordely behaviour in the class.
- e) Blocking gates/doors or passages which would restrict the mobility of staff and students in the college.
- f) Involvement in manhandling or harassing fellow students.
- g) Creating disturbances during functions/programmes by shouting, howling or dancing.
- h) Resorting to anykind of malpractice in the examinations.

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- i) Collecting money from staff or students without the permission of the principal.
- j) Distributing leaflets, hand-bills or other materials and displaying banners and postersinside the campus.
- k) Scribling offensive, abusive or obscene words or figures on black boards or any kind of writing on the walls or other places in the college.
- Smoking, Peddling of alchoholic drinks and narcotics, consumption of alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited. Criminal proceedings will be initiated against those found under the influence of alcohol or narcotic drugs within the campus.
- m) Vandalism and destruction of college property will be severely dealt with and material loss will be fully recovered from the concerned.
- 11. Immorality, Irregular attendance, insubordination to teachers, habitual inattention to class work, contempt for authority, wilful damage to college property, obscenity in word or deed, malpractice in examinations etc; are sufficient reasons for permanent or temporary dismissal of a student.
- 12. When the students meet a member of the staff within the campus or outside, they will greet him /her as a mark of respect.
- 13. Late comers should not enter the classroom, without the permission of the teacher in charge of the class. In any case, late comers will not be given attendance. Parents or guardians are expected to respond to the calls from the college authorities, from time to time.
- 14. Teachers hold the responsibility of maintaining discipline in their classes.
- 15. The members of the college students' council are chosen among the class representatives (one boy and one girl) who are di-

rectly elected from each class. A call to the auditorium or conference hall for any programme must be promptly and strictly responded to. No one should remain in the classrooms or else where during such occcasions.

- 16. Nothing is more appreciated in a student than courteous and mannerly behaviour. Show due respect to your teachers and other staff of the college. Remember, it is rude to enter a room without being asked to; not to say 'Thank you' when something is done for you; to jump queues; to scramble for seats in the bus; to get a person at a door or a passage without saying 'excuse me' or 'sorry' when you have bumped into someone.
- 17. Discipline and decorum is expected from the students during programmes convened in the auditorium or else where.
- 18. It is the responsibility of the student to earn a conduct certificate. It is not issued as a matter of right. Conduct certificate is issued on the basis of an overall evaluation by the teachers concerned.
- 19. Cleanliness in classrooms, verandhas and premises is essential. Avoid leaning against walls and door - ways. Legal action will be initiated against those who destruct or cause to destruct the properties of the college under existing laws including the prevention of Damage to Public Property Act 1984.
- 20. Students who are charged with the criminal offence and are under suspension shall not be allowed to enter the campus without permission.
- 21. Students from the other institutions and outsiders shall not meet or interact with the students of the college inside the campus without the prior written consent of the Principal.
- 22. There shall not be any discrimination against any community or category of students of the college and immediate stringent action will be taken against the erring students/Staff

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- 23. Outsiders including police and media shall not enter the campus without the permission of the college authorities.
- 24. Photography /video/ audio recording/ playing on the campus and in the college bus is strictly prohibited. Media coverage of programmes held in the college shall be done only by authorised personnel.
- 25. Students are not allowed to bring 4 wheelers and 2 wheeler vehicles above 350cc into the campus. They have to park their vehicle at the allotted place at their own risk. Stunting and racing of vehicles with in and in a radiius of 200 metres outside the campus are strictly banned.
- 26. Complaints of students will be looked into if they are presented through the proper channel. Collective petitions, however will not be allowed.
- 27. During the absence of the teacher as well as while moving from one class to another, care should be taken to observe silence.
- 28. Observance of strict silence during morning assembly is compulsory. The assembly commences at 8.50 am on regular working days. Morning assembly is mandatory for both staff and students
- 29. Hostel rules Hostel authorities may frame and issue from time to time disciplinary rules of permanent or temporary character regulating the conduct of students within and outside the college and the hostel premises with a view to maintain the discipline, credit and reputation of the college and the hostel.
- 30. College Students' council election will be conducted according to the Lyngdoh committee report dated 26 May 2006.
- 31. Semester certificate of attendance and progress required for admission to university examination as well as promotion shall not be given unless the applicant has attended at least 75% of the working days of the semester. Absence of 10 consecutive

working days without information will result in the removal of the name from the rolls.

32. The college authorities reserve the rights to amend, repeal or modify any of the above rules. It is the responsibility of the students and staff to get informed of all the rules and notifications of the college from time to time. Ignorance of these rules is not condoned.

Attendance and Promotion

- 1. A student who absents himself from class without seeking leave during any one period of the day shall lose the full attendance of the session.
- 2. Students coming late to class will lose half a day's attendance. The teacher at his/her discretion may admit students who come late. He may also mark them present on a reasonable excuse.
- 3. Attendance will be strictly monitored and no one will be allowed to appear for University examinations if his attendance shortage is beyond 25%. Attendance will not be given for Union activities even if one is holding an elected office.
- 4. The number of absentees shall be put on the notice-board from time to time and any complaints regarding the same should be brought to the notice of the attendance clerk within 3 days.
- 5. Students have to satisfy attendance requirements for admission to end semester examinations.
- 6. The annual attendance and progress certificate shall not be granted unless the student has attendance for three fourth numbers of working days prescribed by the University / college and the conduct of the student has been satisfactory.
- 7. A Student in a junior class who has earned required attendance/progress certificate will be eligible for promotion

to the next higher class only if he has registered for examination at the end of the semester.

- 8. A student who has failed to earn the progress certificate for the academic semester at the end of which there is a semester examination must attend college to receive such additional instruction as the Principal may prescribe so as to enable the Principal to issue the progress certificate.
- 9. No attendance for instruction other than in an institution affiliated to the University shall qualify for admission to any examination of the college.

Certificates

- 1. Every student should take his Transfer Certificate at the end of his programme and produce it when he is admitted for the next programme.
- 2. No student who has previously studied in any recognised school or college (including Sahrdaya College of Advanced Studies, Kodakara) shall be admitted to the college unless he presents the transfer certificate.
- 3. No transfer certificate will be issued to those who have dues left.
- 4. No fee will be levied from those who apply for T.C within one year after leaving the college.
- 5. A fee of Rs.50/- will be levied from those who apply for T.C after the lapse of one year from the date of leaving the college.
- 6. A fine of Rs.100/- will be levied from those who apply for duplicate copy of the T.C.
- 7. A duplicate transfer certificate may be issued to a candidate only when the original is irrecoverably lost and on producing a written declaration made by the candidate in the prescribed form together with a certificate from a Judicial Magistrate in support of the declaration.

Form of declaration for duplicate T.C;

"I do hereby solemnly declare that the transfer certificate already issued to me was not utilized by me for appointment to any post or for admission to any programme of studies. The transfer certificate has been lost irrecoverably. In case I could trace the T.C after the issue of a duplicate, I shall surrender the same to the authorities forthwith".

- 8. No certificate will be sent by post unless the necessary selfaddressed stamped envelope is enclosed with the application.
- 9. A duplicate identity card will not be normally issued. However on recommendation of the principal, a duplicate card will be issued at a cost of Rs.100/-.On any account there will be no issue of more than two cards.
- 10. The college will own no responsibility for certificate if any, retained after six months of the completion of one's course or discontinuance from studies.

Library and Reading Room

- 1. It is obligatory for all the students to become members of the College Library.
- 2. The Library is closed on Sundays, Second Saturdays and other public holidays.
- 3. Books from the Reference Section shall not be taken outside the Library. They will be issued for use inside the Library during working hours. The use and issue of other books from the Library shall be governed by the following rules:
- a. On receiving the books, students must check them thoroughly and report to the library staff of any damage found there in. If they fail to do so, they will be held responsible for the damage found on returning the book.

- b. Undergraduate students are allowed to take three books and Postgraduate students may take six books at a time. Teaching staff are allowed to take ten books at a time while non-teaching staff can borrow three at a time.
- c. Books may be kept for 14 days by the users including students, teaching and non-teaching staff, but this period will be shortened in particular cases. They can be renewed for a further period of seven days if no one else has applied for the same books. The renewal should be done by the users themselves during 12th, 13th, or 14th day of issue of books, by logging into their online library accounts.
- d. A staff or student failing to return the book within the prescribed time will have to pay a fine of Re.1.00 per day (including holidays). The book is detained and the member will be suspended from membership till the fine is paid. Absence from college will not be accepted as an excuse for not returning the books on time.
- e. Sub-lending and transferring of books to another person's name are not allowed.
- f. If a book is damaged, lost or spoiled, the member will have either to pay three times the price of the latest edition of the book or supply the Library with a new copy. If the lost book is not available for replacement the value of the lost book will be realized at rates regulated by the Government.
- g. At the end of each term all books must be returned three days before the close of the term. In the case of students appearing for semester examination, they should return the books three days before the last working day. All the books borrowed from the Library by students and members of teaching and non-teaching staff must be returned within the first week of March every year.

- h. Books not exceeding two may be borrowed for the Onam or Christmas holidays; all such books should be returned within three days after the reopening.
- i. Issue of Transfer Certificates and refund of caution deposit is done only after clearing all Library dues.
- j. No book which has been prescribed as a textbook for a class shall be lent to the students during the period for which it is prescribed as textbook.
- k. Members are forbidden to remove any page/content from any document from the Library.
- 4. Strict silence must be observed in the Library and its immediate premises.
- 5. Personal belongings such as umbrellas, bags, tiffin carriers etc., are to be kept in the racks available at the entrance of the Library. Sleeping and indecorous behaviour are prohibited inside the Library.

Fee Regulations

- 1. Students are requested to keep the all receipts of the payments made at the office till they receive all the certificates of the course they are pursuing.
- 2. A fine will be charged for delay in payment.
- 3. Students are advised to plan their bank remittances in advance before the banking day. The chalan can be obtained from the College Office during working days. Mention the purpose of remittance, amount, and get it counter signed and sealed (college seal) by the office staff.

Two periods are allotted for add-on courses.

The day begins with the morning Prayer session. All the staff and the students line up at the auditorium at 8:55 am. Late coming will be considered as serious disobedience.

Study groups and Morning Assembly:

The sessions are lead by the student study groups. Each study group submits a detailed report of their programme on the previous day, at the office duly signed by the Class-in-charge, for the approval of the Executive Director. The Programme includes Prayer, Thought for the Day, Daily News Headlines, Message from the Executive Director / Principal and College Anthem.

Dress Code

- 1. Students are instructed to wear the official uniform of the college on all working days.
- 2. The supply of the material and the tailoring will be taken care of by the college. The charges pertaining to this are to be paid at the college store.
- 3. The students should also follow the dress code on occasions when they are representing the college participating in intercollegiate competitions, study tours, social service etc.

Boys:

- * Shirt should be properly tucked inside the trousers.
- * They are expected to have a formal haircut at all times.
- * They shall wear neatly polished formal black shoes with black socks.

Girls:

- * They shall wear neatly polished formal black shoes.
- * They should have their hair neatly done. A neatly tied pony tail for short hair and well plaited hair for long hair is advisable.
- 4. Girls and boys are not allowed to wear precious ornaments.
- 5. Students are permitted to use colour dress with ID card on the following occasions:
 - * Fresher's Day (for freshers only)
 - * 1st November (Kerala Piravi)
 - * Onam Celebrations
 - * Sports Day

* Arts Day

The colour dress permitted in the campus are as follows:

Boys: Executive Pants & Shirts tucked in properly; with shoes. (Dhoti, T-Shirts, Baniyans, Jeans etc. are not allowed).

Girls: Churidar with duppatta. No other form of attire is permitted in the campus.

- 6 During monsoon (June /July) shoes and socks are optional.
- 7. Any student who is found in non-uniform will be penalized.

Identity Card

- 1. Students will be issued an Identity Card. They are expected to wear it while inside the campus, during inter-collegiate competitions, study tours, social service etc. and should furnish it for all official transactions in the college.
- 2. The Identity Card has to be surrendered at the office after the completion of the course or at the time of issuance of TC, whichever is earlier.
- 3. A student will be issued a Duplicate Identity Card only if he produces a declaration stating that the original identity card is irrecoverably lost; the declaration must be countersigned by his/her parent/guardian and the issue will be on payment of the administrative charges.

Use of two-wheelers

- 1. Students who wish to commute to college on two-wheelers are required to submit an application to the Principal in the prescribed form.
- 2. The speed limit inside the campus is 20 km/ph.
- 3. Students using two-wheelers are required to reach college before 8:50 am.
- 4. They are not allowed to leave their vehicles in the College Portico at any cause. The vehicles have to be parked in the parking lot only.
- 5. They are not permitted to drive the vehicles beyond the permitted limits.

College Bus

- 1. Regular transportation facilities are provided to major locations.
- 2. Students can get details of the time of arrival of the buses at various locations from the Front Office.
- 3. The buses shall depart from the College at 4:10 pm every day.
- 4. Students who would like to avail the transport facility have to remit the prescribed fee and obtain the bus pass.
- 5. No student will be allowed to travel in the college bus without the valid bus pass.
- 6. The bus pass has to be produced to the college authorities whenever asked for.
- 7. Students are expected to maintain discipline while travelling by the college bus.

Reprography - Kiosk

- 1. Photocopying from any reference book has to be recommended by the faculty concerned.
- 2. A maximum of 10 pages from a book can be taken.
- 3. Books have to be returned without any damage within the allotted time, failing which, Rs. 10/- per hour shall be collected as fine.

Cafeteria

- 1. The dining area provided for hostellers to dine should be kept neat.
- 2. Do not spill or waste food.
- 3. Maintain discipline in and around the area.

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INTERNAL/MODEL EXAMINATION

- 1. Internal / model examinations in all courses will be conducted as directed by the University.
- 2. The date and time of the internal / model examinations will be informed to the students well in advance.
- 3. All the students have to appear for the internal / model examinations and no leave will be granted for those days.
- 4. Students who fail to appear for the internal / model examinations without prior permission are required to bring their parent / guardian on the very next day and appropriate action will be taken.
- 5. Whatever be the reason for absence, re-test/test improvement will not be conducted for those who have not appeared for the internal/model examinations.
- 6. The marks secured by the students will be informed to their parents through the Student Progress Report.
- 7. Any kind of malpractice in the exam hall will be seriously dealt with. Students resorting to such deeds will be asked to leave the hall immediately and the matter will be reported to the Principal.

ASSIGNMENT & SEMINAR

Assignment:

- 1. As required by the University, students will be required to submit assignments in all courses of the programme.
- 2. Questions for assignments, the format and the last date of submission will be given to the student well in advance.
- 3. The assignment should be submitted on or before the date of submission. Non-submission or delayed submission will be seriously dealt with.

- 4. Students can refer to text books, reference books etc. for writing the assignment.
- 5. Assignments should be handwritten by the student and has to be presented in the prescribed format only.
- 6. Students are not allowed to share their assignments with their classmates.
- 7. The grades once granted will be final and no improvement is allowed in case of substandard assignments.

Seminar:

- 1. As required by the University, students will be required to present a seminar in all courses of the programme.
- 2. The topic for seminar, the format and the date of presentation will be given to the student well in advance.
- 3. The seminar report has to be submitted one week before the presentation for the approval of the faculty concerned. Non-submission or delayed submission will be seriously dealt with.
- 4. The presentation should be done on the assigned date. Students can refer text books, reference books etc. for the preparation of the seminar report.
- 5. Seminar report should be handwritten by the student and has to be presented in the prescribed format only.
- 6. The grades once granted will be final and no improvement is allowed in case of seminar presentation.

EDUCATIONAL TOUR

All students are expected to undertake an educational tour during the course in the Third and Fifth Semester.

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Third Semester Tour: All the students are advised to visit an industry / institute in their area of specialization.

Guidelines for educational tour

1. The tour is not compulsory but optional.

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- 2. Students should produce No Objection Letter from their parent/guardian in the prescribed format.
- 3. They have to be accompanied by a male and a female faculty, a male and a female parent representative. A female faculty and a female parent are compulsory when girls are participating the tour.
- 4. The following details should be furnished two weeks before the journey
 - a. The itinerary Details of the place(s) of visit, stay and route (including the address and phone number)
 - b. List of students participating in the tour
 - c. Estimate of the tour programme
 - d. Estimate of the per head contribution

The above mentioned details have to be prepared in consultation with the faculty accompanying the students for the tour and the Head of the Department and approved by the Head of the Institution.

5. Permission for a tour will be granted only when the above stated requirements are fulfilled and at least 75% of the students in the class are participating in the tour.

General rules

- 1. The students joining the tour should maintain discipline and dignity of the College.
- 2. The ID Card has to be worn while on industrial visits.
- 3. They have to strictly adhere to the instructions of the accompanying faculty.
- 4. The students who are misbehaving during a tour will not be recommended for further tour programmes.

5. The Principal holds the authority of recommending / not recommending any student for a tour without assigning any reason.

STUDENTS' COUNCIL

The various positions in College Students' Council are:

- 1. The President of the Student Council is the Principal (ex-officio)
- 2. Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary and Joint Secretary
- 3. The Secretaries of the various College Associations.
- 4. One representative of I DC, II DC and III DC classes stand elected by the students of the respective classes.
- 5. The Student Editor of the College Magazine.
- 6. Secretary of Fine Arts.
- 7. General Captain
- 8. The Staff Advisor nomiated by the President.

The Union Secretary shall act as the Secretary of the Executive Committee. All the office bearers of the Students' Council will be nominated by the Principal in consultation with the animators and Head of the Departments.

STUDY GROUPS

Study Groups / Leaders

- * Study groups will be formed in all the classes with 5-8 members.
- * One of the members will be the group leader.
- * The group leader should not have any back paper.
- * The number of boys and girls in a study group shall be equal.
- No group will consist of only boys or girls, unless it is permitted by the Principal.
- * New groups will be formed each semester.

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* Four study groups will be administered by an animator.

Animators

- The animators are to maintain an up-to-date record of all the students in the study group.
- * They are required to meet the students regularly at least once a month, monitor their progress, guide them as required and furnish the report to the Principal.

Class Leader / Assistant Class Leader

- The term of class leader / assistant class leader shall be one year.
- They will be nominated by the Principal in consultation with the animators from among the group leaders.
- * They shall not have any back paper.
- * One boy and a girl shall hold the two positions.
- * New nominations should take place each year.

RESOURCES AND SERVICES

1. HED

The Human Excellence Department of Sahrdaya College of Advanced Studies is dedicated to provide service, assistance, and resources to the College's most important asset: its staff and the students. Our goal is to respond quickly and efficiently to the concerns of the students and staff so as to achieve better outcome. We believe that contribution of each staff and student of the College is valuable to the fulfillment of our mission.

2. Library

Libraries have quite a lot to do with the input, creation, and retention of ideologies of a knowledge seeker. The College Library aims at providing the necessary information and to make it accessible to each of the beneficiary at the right time. It's objective is to improve student success rates by maintaining a balanced collection of books, journals, periodicals, dailies and other information sources along with the reference books for the student community, supporting the University curriculum. A good number of reference books, of national

and international publications are made available to the learners enrolled in different programmes. The library functions in coordination with the specialized libraries in the University and is well maintained by a qualified and experienced librarian.

3. Computer Lab

When it comes to technology in general or for academic purpose, acquainting with some of the Operating Systems and Softwares, Computer Lab and its facilities is an imperative necessity. Sahrdaya offers a variety of facilities for use by all the students, faculty and staff of SCAS. All the computers in the lab are equipped with the latest softwares and provide students of Sahrdaya access to the internet, true of our directive to provide efficient and effective information delivery. Qualified hands manage the sessions with the students in the lab and the lab can be accessed by them during college hours.

4. Chapel

To strongly support the mission of the College, a house of worship where a pleasant breeze of hope and peace blows is inevitable. A beautiful Chapel has been erected for the spiritual, psychological and physical upbringing of those associated with the college. It aims at providing regular times of worship to honour and know God. Holy mass on the first Friday of every month and other religious observations are carried out at this blessed chapel. Special prayers for individuals and the public at large, celebrations and mourning of losses are prominent among others.

5. Auditorium

We take special interest in bringing up and nurturing the unrecognized talents of each individual student of the college. Literary, art, knowledge-based, cultural competitions are conducted on a regular basis and presentations to enhance their academic competence are as well of significant consideration. For this purpose, the college currently provides an open spacious Auditorium with a seating capacity of 300 people. The paraphernalia of the auditorium include a professional quality sound system, amplifiers, etc. Other facilities include a LCD Projector and presenter.

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Career Guidance & Placement Cell

At present, the Career Guidance & Placement Cell is constituted with staff and student representatives, to identify openings in the industry, for those seeking jobs after the completion of their programme. It also aims at providing industry relevant training so as to make them employable. Another functional objective of the Cell is to aid our candidates with career guidance.

7. Counselling Centre

Of late, an increase in the mental health requirements of college students has been reported by Counseling Centres and student affairs personnel world-wide. Our state is no exception to this. The major underlying reasons behind the rising need for counseling among the College-goers can be listed as stress, anxiety, confusion, uncertainty about the future; problems related to decision making, adjusting with college life and college mates, concentrating on studies; loneliness and depression; self-esteem, family and relationship issues; changes in eating and sleeping habits; worries about making or keeping friends and the like, leading to isolation, suicidal tendencies, alchoholism and drug addiction.

The college authorities intend to check such issues relating to the students and it is done by well qualified, experienced and practising Counselors.

8. Grievance Redressal Cell

Grievance Redressal Cell constituted in the college has been continuously striving to solve problems of the students in a rapid and effective manner. A complaint box has been kept in the office where students can drop in their complaints. In most of the cases, the solutions are provided without much delay. Depending on the severity of the complaint, the members come together to review the case. The Cell intends to continue providing better service to the aggrieved students on genuine issues and for the effective functioning of the college.

9. Internal Quality Assurance Cell

Continuous and comprehensive feedback pertaining to aspects such as infrastructural facilities and amenities provided; is taken from students of each programme at the start and the end of each semester quality and attitude of faculty members, non-teaching staff etc. Students are also encouraged to give their suggestions for further enhancement and betterment of the facilities provided.

10. Hostel for boys and girls

The college provides residential facilities for students who have enrolled for different courses offered by the college. They are well-ventilated dormitories, spacious and neatly maintained. The hostel provides facilities that aid the children to live and grow in a congenial atmosphere. The Warden and the supporting staff are well trained and experienced in dealing with and meeting the needs of the children of this age group; dedicated and caring staff members ensure that the children remain happy and stress-free during their course of study. The administrators make it a point to see that the personality and character of each child is moulded in the best possible manner over the period of time they spend here. The hostel and its framework are designed in such a manner that it plays a vital role in the academic progress of the students through a well planned and organized schedule. From the Academic Year 2013-14, we have been providing separate hostel for boys within the college premises.

11. Transportation

The students are provided with transportation facility from major locations around the college. Students seeking admission to the college can contact the college office for further details regarding provision for commutation.

12. Blue Huts for group study

Organizing study circles is not a novel concept, nevertheless, when it comes to an educational institution, making learning enjoyable is of prime importance. Factors such as moving out of the closed walls of the classroom for learning, often supervised by a leader or

a facilitator, cordial discussions leading to healthy relationships and concept building are vital parts of a student's character formation and intellectual development.

Keeping in mind the highest level of satisfaction in learning for the student and the faculty, the college has provided adequately furnished and lighted study huts inside the lush green and scenic campus amongst the shady trees and pools. Students can even bring in their laptops and make use of the electric circuits provided in the study huts.

13. Dining Hall

A college mess functions in the college. It provides support to the hostelers, day scholars and staff members. The college canteen also offers a wide range of healthy food items, both vegetarian and non vegetarian hygienic and homely.

14. Cafeteria

A counter selling inexpensive snacks has been yet another initiative of the college to refresh the students and the staff during recesses. Besides providing fresh juice, snacks, candies, chocolate bars, goodies and soft drinks, the counter acts as a stationery store where the students can procure the stationary items they need.

15. Recreation Room

The management aims at sensitizing the students on health and fitness. 'Sports for Everyone' is our motive. The benefits of sports are intended to be reaped by all, irrespective of the gender. We realise the relavance and importance of sports as an instrument of life quality improvement and social development. We recognize and respect the students their right to socialise, right to play and enjoy their college life at college. Table Tennis court and facilities for indoor games are in the list of amenities aimed at, for the overall blooming of the personality of our students.

16. College Store

The college store provides University prescribed text books for students of all courses at concessional rates. The students can avail this facility at the start of each semester.

17. Reprographic Centre - KIOSK

This facility can be made use of by the students during the college hours.

18. Parking

A spacious parking lot is provided to the staff and the students of the college, which can be made use of during college hours.

OTHER INITIATIVES

1. Sahrdaya Charity Fund

The management has done a splendid work of raising a Charity Fund in the very first year of its inception keeping in view the need of instilling the thought of giving and sharing in students. The Exofficio members of Sahrdaya charity fund are the Chairman, the Manager, the Executive Director, the Principal, the Staff Secretary and the Chairman of the Students' Council. The Executive body is constituted with a teaching staff, non-teaching staff and a student from each Department.

2. Sahrdaya Media Correspondence (SMC)

SMC is a spanking new concept and the college is proud to introduce it in the very first year of its functioning. SMC is a fullfledged media operation in itself. The Executive Director, the staff and the students constitute the group. Here, the student correspondents of each department gather, edit and read the news articles with photography shot on high quality Digital Camera. The news articles comprehensively cover the message from the Executive Director, Principal, announcements, University news, programmes for the forthcoming weeks and the same are aired on a weekly basis on the LED TV displayed in the Reception Lobby.

3. LAUREOLA – The Tri-monthly Newsletter

'Laureola' is a word derived from Latin which means triumph or victory. This newsletter is published by the Executive Director, every three months, covering all major events of the college, highlighting new initiatives, contributions from students, staff and much more. The task of compiling the content, designing and adding novel inputs into the newsletter is assigned to each Department in turns. The class in-charge is the Chief Editor and the students of the Department constitute the Editorial Board.

4. Add - on Courses

To keep pace with the requirements of the current competitive job market, a flexible system offering Add-on courses is running parallel to the conventional B.Sc, BCA, B.Com and BBA degree programmes. These courses are conducted alongside the academic session from the start of each Academic Year. The programmes have been designed in consensus with the students' and industry demands. At the end of graduation, the college intends to award the students with Certifications in the respective Add-on courses.
