
Alumni Feedback Report 2016-17

During The Academic Year 2016-17, An Alumni Feedback On Curriculum Was Conducted And The Total Number Of Feedback Received Was 498. About 80 Percentage Of The Alumni Strongly Agreed To The Question Of Relevance Of Courses In Relation To The Programme Offered. Majority Of Them Were Of The Opinion That The Course Increased Their Knowledge Level And Understanding Of The Subject And Added That That Prescribed Books Were Relevant, Updated And Appropriate. Majority Of The Respondents Were Of The Opinion That The Syllabus Was Need Based As Per The Requirement Of The Industry/ Job. More That 85 Percentage Of The Respondents Positively Rated The Academic Initiatives Undertaken By The College To Bridge The Gap Between Industry And Academia And About 80 Percentage Positively Rated The Relevance Of Their Degree To The Present Job. About 85 Percentage Of The Respondents Strongly Agreed To The Fact That The Activities Like Seminars, Workshops Projects, And Study Tour Have Improved Their Competency




Rate the relevance of courses in relation to the programme

Feedback %






Course/syllabus increased the knowledge and understanding of the subject studied Feedback %













STUDENT FEEDBACK ON REPORT CURRICULUM 2016-17


Relevance of the topics prescribed for employability






Knowledge level earned from topics of study




Motivation to attempt self learning






Updated information dissemination on Regulations and Syllabus


Faculty Feedback Report 2016-17






Curriculum facilitates adoption of new techniques and strategies of teaching Feedback %
