The department started functioning with Ms. Annamma C.C as the Head of the Department. The newly renovated college indoor stadium blessing and inauguration was held on 5<sup>th</sup> August 2016 at 2.00 pm.

## **ISO CERTIFICATION PROCESS**

Sahrdaya College of Advanced Studies aspired to be an ISO certified institution at the 6<sup>th</sup> year of its functioning as an Arts and Science College. A committee was constituted to spearhead the activities, with Prof. K J Davis as its Chief Coordinator (CCO) and Ms. Annie faith as the Deputy Coordinator (DCCO) along with 13 internal auditors from various departments . The members of the committee included representatives from each department.

The first meeting of the committee was held in August 2017 and Prof. K J Davis explained the primary steps to be taken to systematize the filing pattern of various departments. Our consultants, Mr. Kiran and team visited each departments and collected lists of files maintained in each department. They categorized them under various titles, and monitored the labeling of files in a uniform pattern. Reference numbers were given to files so that identification of files and documentation of details under each title become easy. Staff representatives monitored and ensured the process and its completion in their assigned departments.

Once the filing, labeling processes got over, the consultants re-checked the arrangements and suggested changes and improvements were executed meticulously. The first Management review meeting was conducted on 22.02.2018. The external audit team, QMPG – Industrial & Certification Service, Kochi -38 visited the college for the first External Audit in February, 2018. On the basis of the audit findings, corrective measures were taken and by 19<sup>th</sup> February 2018, the college was ready for its Final External Audit prior to ISO Certification. On 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2018 the final audit was conducted by QMPG. On finding the college complying with the regulatory and statutory requirements of ISO 9001: 2015, the college was recommended for ISO Certification. ISO 2009: 2015 awarded by DAS Certification UK wide Certification No. DAS 40384631/ 47/Q dated 15.05.2018.
