- **REMEDIAL CLASSES**

Remedial classes are given to the weaker students according to their performance in the class as well as exams. Through sessions teachers give proper instructions which help them to improve their academic excellence.

- **VALUE EDUCATION**

- **ADD ON COURSES**

Students are encouraged to have fun with words, sounds, spellings and structures including crosswords, quizzes, guessing games, creative ideas and presentations, Teamwork activities, problem solving thereby teasing their linguistic brain centres and developing a profound interest for necessary Skills. ADD-ON Courses deviates from the usual run of courses and it aims at generating better equipped and skilled individuals with critical and creative acumen for entry into various sectors.

- **(SEEP) Sahrdaya Employability Enhancement Programme Team**

CET (Competitive Exam Training)

The programme helps students to excel in competitive world and proposes to spot their talent early in life and nourish them to bloom in full might. - **ASAP (Additional Skill Advancement project)**

Personal, Social, Organizational and Professional Skills and English Proficiency are the major areas that need to be strengthened. From the time human race evolved to form civilizations it has been striving to achieve advancement and progress in all spheres of life. But along with advancements, diseases and illnesses also have plagued humanity which often escalated into epidemics and pandemics in various forms causing massive loss of human lives. What is an epidemic or a pandemic? An epidemic is a disease that affects a large number of people within a community, population or region. A pandemic is an epidemic that reach massive proportions affecting multiple countries or continents. It is said that widespread trade which created new opportunities for human and animal interaction sped up epidemics, rising global connections and human interactions created pandemics. It is believed that the earliest reported pandemic dates to as long back as 2500 years ago. In the centuries following, human race was confronted with other vicious pandemics ranging from the plague to the cholera to the Spanish flu, to name a few, but the resilient nature of mankind overpowered these adversities and continued to progress. In the 21 century we were yet again confronted with another virus outbreak in the form of Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS) caused by a corona virus. Corona viruses are zoonotic viruses, meaning, these viruses are able to be transmitted from animals to humans. SARS was manifested by respiratory distress accompanied by fever, chills and rigors. Other symptoms like headache, malaise and muscle pain were also reported. This disease condition first emerged in the Guangdong Province of China in November 2002, and it lasted until 2004, by which time it grew into an epidemic infecting over 8,000 people from 29 different countries claiming more than 700 lives worldwide. Currently, we are yet again witnessing the rapid spread of another corona virus, a novel corona virus – gripping the whole world and reaching massive proportions for it to be declared as a pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO) on March 11, 2020. This virus, termed as COVID - 19 by WHO on 11 February 2020 was first documented in Wuhan, China in December 2019. The common signs of COVID-19 infection are similar to those of common cold and include respiratory symptoms such as dry cough, fever, shortness of breath and breathing difficulties. It is spread from one person to another via droplets produced from the respiratory system of infected people, often during coughing or sneezing. The preventive measures include

social distancing, wearing of masks, hand washing, sanitizing and quarantining. The spread of this novel coronavirus, COVID-19, is rapid and ongoing engulfing the whole world. It has afflicted more than 180 countries killing millions of people worldwide. India currently has the highest number of confirmed cases in Asia and second only to the USA in the world and is third in COVID-19 related deaths. The first case of novel corona virus infection in India was reported in Thirssur, Kerala, on January 30, 2020, when a young medical student presented to the hospital with a one-day history of dry cough and sore throat after returning from Wuhan, China. There were not many cases in January and February in India, but March 2020 witnessed an unbridled surge in cases. Several people with travel history to affected countries as well as mas gathering without adequate precautions spearheaded the upsurge. The spread of the virus was rapid and the severity of the condition acute. Taking this grim situation into consideration, the government of Kerala announced a complete lockdown on 23 March 2020 and the whole nation went into lockdown mode by 25 March 2020. In spite of this, the cases continued to rise in India and by mid-September over 90,000 cases were reported per day but finally dropped to below 15,000 in January 2021. At the initial stages itself, the government of Kerala boosted its health and hygiene department and took the necessary steps to contain the community spread and the patients were kept in isolation. People who had a travel history were to undergo mandatory quarantine initially for several days and get tested after the required period. Because of these strict measures the government was able to flatten the curve at least for some time while in almost all the other states the spike continued. When a catastrophe strikes the nation unawares, panic grips the people and the student community who is vulnerable feel insecure and has a difficult time coping with the situation. Realizing this, authorities at Sahrdaya College of Advanced Studies were quick to assess the situation during the initial stages of the outbreak itself and discussions were held to chart out necessary action plans and to educate the students. As a result, a talk by a medical professional, Dr. Aleena Antony, Department of Critical Medicine, St. James Hospital, Chalakkudy was hosted by the college on 4 February 2020 to create awareness among its students. It was conducted in the seminar hall of the college wherein participated. This gave the students an opportunity to ask questions regarding the disease condition and the steps to be taken to curtail the spread of the virus. Further, college Executive Director Rev. Dr. Devis Chenginiyadan and Principal Dr. P.O. Jenson addressed the students during assembly to reassure and support them. In his address, the Rev. Dr. Devis Chenginiyadan talked about the psycho-spiritual wellbeing of an individual. In the same month, on 5 February 2020, the third-year psychology students conducted an audiovisual program to create awareness about the novel corona virus and its effects. This was conducted in the central auditorium for the benefit of the whole college students. The students reiterated the importance of maintaining social distancing and hand sanitizing. The information coming from peers were very well received by all the students. This was the first time that the word “quarantine” was introduced to the students and the need for it to be practiced by those with a travel history as a measure to curtail the spread of the virus. This assembly created an awareness among the students. In the assembly the following day, on 06 February 2020, our Executive Director, Rev. Dr. Devis Chenginiyadan while giving a message to the students on corona further emphasized the importance of social distancing and hand sanitization. The Government of Kerala had initiated a Break-the-Chain campaign with a message to break the chain-like spreading of the virus. In Sahrdaya College of Advanced Studies a committee was formed on 16 March 2020, to take the necessary steps in support of this Break-the- Chain campaign of the Government. This committee was formed as per the order of the State Government to engage in the management and prevention of spread of the novel corona virus. This committee had Fr. Shaju Chirayath (Finance Officer, SCAS), Prof. Babu Antony (Head of the Department, Dept. of Chemistry), Mr. M.K. Jaison (office clerk), and Mr. Varghese Poovathukaadan as its members. Two days later, on 18 March 2020, noticing the need for an awareness regarding hygiene, the chemistry

department both staff and students, along with the college management with the cooperation of COVID Cell made hand sanitizers and handwash in their laboratory. This step was taken as part of the Break-the-Chain campaign. Executive Director of SCAS, Rev. Dr. Devis Chenginiyadan handed over these products to the Kodakara Grama Panchayat President, Mr. P.R. Prasad for distribution in the panchayat. Following this, the college also installed additional wash basins in every nook and corner of the college and hand sanitizers were made freely available to the students to encourage frequent hand washing and sanitization. These were also placed at the various entrance points to the college. Pursuant to the order of the Higher Education (K) Department in its circular No. G.O.(Rt.) No.489/2020/HEDN dated 23-03-2020 mandating the formation of a Covid Cell in every college, an official cell was made with some modification and addition to the existing cell. Thus, on 25 March 2020 the cell was modified and had Fr. Shaju Chiryath as its Nodal Officer and Prof. A.K. Simon (Dept. of Commerce), Ms. Greeni K.I. (Dept. of Chemistry), Mr. Akhil Anto (Dept. of English), Mr. Paul K. Antony (Senior Clerk) as its new members. All the activities conducted thus far were officially consolidated in this one cell to be managed under one umbrella. The State had gone into lockdown mode starting March 24 and after the initial euphoria of not having to attend college, trepidation soon set in in the students. In April and May, therefore, online general counseling was provided to the needy students by college counselors. Meanwhile, the students and staff engaged themselves proactively by collecting and making masks and sanitizers. A series of webinars were conducted by various departments of the college in their respective subjects to motivate the students and keep them focused. Parallel webinars were also conducted by the counseling and psychology departments to educate the students more about Corona and keep them abreast of new findings and repercussions of the infection. The situation has long escalated into a pandemic and the lockdown created a sense of apprehension and insecurity in everyone. To alleviate the fears arising from such a situation the counseling section of the college also engaged in providing tele-counseling services to the students as needed.

It was the beginning of May and we saw no end to the rise in coronavirus infections and it was during this period that SCAS decided to reach out to the society. On 1 June, 2020, it was the start of a fresh academic year but we saw no abatement of the virus. SCAS had several outreach programs on the anvil to be held as part of the Break-the-Chain campaign. Along with the inauguration of the new academic year, this project was also flagged off with an inauguration by Rev. Msgr. Prof. Dr. Lazar Kuttikadan, Manager, Sahridaya College of Advanced Studies. Along with this he delivered a message of encouragement to the staff members as they begin a new academic year. He executed the launch of COVID-19 outreach activity of distributing face masks and sanitization to public by handing over the products to Vice Principal, Dr. Rani M.J. Subsequently, on 4 June the COVID Cell of the college distributed prevention kits to the families of Sasthampooam Tribal Colony through Kodakara Panchayath in the presence of Panchayath members and Anganwadi teachers of the Panchayath. On 06 June 2020, in preparation for the University Exams, all the classrooms of the college and the surroundings were disinfected using bleaching solution which was made in the college and sanitized. All safety precautions such as social distancing, hand sanitization, proper wearing of masks and other COVID protocols were also strictly adhered to during the exam by both students as well as invigilators. This also included wearing of face shields and gloves by the invigilators. Sanitizers were made freely available. Transportation was provided to the students, temperature of every student was checked, and face masks were made compulsory. Later, on June 8, another outreach activity was conducted by SCAS and in this program kits that included sanitizers and handwash were distributed to MGNRE (Mahatma Gandhi National Employment Scheme) workers as well as to

the auto drivers in Kodakara Grama Panchayath to create awareness about COVID-19. Since Sahrdaya College of Advanced Studies (SCAS) is located in ward 16 of the Kodakara Grama Panchayath, it strives to work toward the wellbeing and upliftment of its residents. Hence during this pandemic period SCAS considered it as a duty to take this ward under its wing and as part of the Breakthe-Chain campaign, the college, jointly with the panchayath, engaged in distribution of prevention kits to the families of its ward. On 16 June 2020, the Human Excellence Department of SCAS conducted a webinar on COVID-19 Mental Health Impact. The resource person was Dr. Varghese Punnooth, Head of the Department, Dept. of Psychiatry, Alappuzha Medical College. On 17 June 2020, the Psychology Department conducted a webinar on stress management and Rev. Dr. Rajeev, Clinical Psychologist, St. Joseph's Hospital, Manjummal was the resource person. On 20 June 2020, thermal scanner was introduced in the college and a movement register was also maintained for visitors. In addition, automatic sanitizer dispenser was also placed at the reception. All members of staff were provided with hot water with turmeric, lemon and other natural ingredients with medicinal properties to boost the immune system.

Containment zones and cluster containment zones were declared and banks and other institutions were instructed to avoid crowding. SCAS continued with its social service programs like fumigating the Kodakara market places in cooperation with the panchayath during weekends, distributing food to the needy, and the like. On 27 July 2020 prevention kits were supplied to the families of Ward 16. On 17 August 2020 such kits as well as food supplies were distributed again in the ward. During the weeks of offline classes conducted as per the orders and guidelines of the university the same protocol was maintained and adhered to by SCAS. A Counter Corona campaign was also initiated by the physical education department of the college through a video series on physical fitness and health. As part of this program, a fitness challenge program was also started on 17 September 2020 for the staff of SCAS through online and offline mode. This was made to propagate the importance of physical and mental fitness through Yoga and light sport activities at home during this pandemic period. On 25 September 2020 the COVID Cell was further expanded to include additional members. Accordingly, Ms. Glancy Joy (Dept. of Computer Science), Ms. Jisna Arakkal (Office Staff) and Ms. Savithri M. (Coordinator, Women Development Cell) were added to the Cell. On 7 October 2020, a webinar on an overview of "COVID-19 Pandemic and Role of Medicinal Plants in the Mitigation of Epidemic" was conducted by the Department of Chemistry with Dr. K. V. Radhakrishnan, (Sr. Principal Scientist & Head, organic chemistry, NIIST, TVM) as the resource person. Again, on 17 October 2020, disinfection of public spaces of Kodakara Panchayat was carried out by SCAS. On 13 January 2021, as an extension of its support to the society, SCAS conducted an outreach program "Njungalundu koodu" athijeevanathinoru kaithangu" with the cooperation of the Kodakara panchayat in its central auditorium. In this event, the residents of ward 16 were presented with blankets and masks in the presence of the Panchayath president and other members. By this time, on January 16, 2021, the government of Kerala started its vaccination drive, initially for persons 60 years and older. But, again, March 2021 saw a second wave of the corona virus and it was more devastating than the first. More people experienced respiratory difficulties and the hospitals started running out of beds and the government was running out of vaccines. Adding to this predicament was the shortage of oxygen cylinders and medicines in

many parts of the country. The cases began to spike and by April India became the first country to report a daily case of over 40,000 in a 24-hour period. Taking into consideration the unaccounted and unreported cases, health experts believe it must have been an underestimate. Now, the need to get vaccinated was the need of the hour, but due to the skepticism of a large number of people, coupled with limited computer literacy, many were hesitant to take the vaccine. So, on 16 April 2021, the COVID Cell of the college together with its NSS unit joined hands with Kodakara Panchayat and arranged an awareness program to bring home the importance and need of getting vaccinated. Further, on 17 April COVID Cell conducted a survey to identify the number of non-vaccinated residents in its ward and encouraged them to get vaccinated. It also provided assistance to the residents in getting registered in the Cowin Portal. On 13 May 2021 at the request of the Panchayat, SCAS counselors provided tele-counseling to the residents of ward 16. On 23 May 2021, SCAS took a step ahead in its efforts to lending a helping hand to the society and handed over medical equipment such as pulse oximeters, digital thermometers, and steamers to the Kodakara panchayat president to be used for the benefit of the society.

DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHOLOGY

- ❖ The spread of pandemic COVID-19 has drastically disrupted every aspects of human life including education. All over the world COVID19 situation has released a sudden spurt of demand for online teaching and learning. Lockdown-induced closure of higher education institutions has been compelling teachers and students too to resort to online mode. COVID induced virtual mode is not just a technological alternative to the actual teaching learning system. Capable of reshaping many of the established educational practices and their environment, it would bring about a series of transformations in the concept of higher education institutions, their clientele and practices.
- ❖ Since the beginning of 2020, we have been facing a crisis of enormous proportions. But it also gives us an opportunity to turn this crisis into a driving force for achieving sustainable alternative method of imparting quality education. The P G department of psychology, SCAS, Kodakara also decided to go ahead with the online classes
- ❖ Online classes were started on 1st June 2020 for III and V semester B.Sc. Psychology students and III semester M.Sc. Psychology and M. S.c. Clinical psychology students. Online classes for I Semester B.Sc. psychology were started on 2nd November 2020. Due to COVID 19 pandemic, classes for both 1st semester M.Sc. Psychology and M.Sc Clinical Psychology were delayed and started on 23rd November 2020.
- ❖ Sixth semester B.Sc. psychology Online classes were started on 2nd November 2020. Fourth semester M.Sc. psychology and M.Sc. clinical psychology online classes were started on 19th November 2020 after their semester exams.
- ❖ II semester B.Sc. psychology Online classes were started on 15th March 2021.
- ❖ Second semester M.Sc. psychology and M.Sc. clinical psychology online classes were started on 29th March 2021

BRIDGE COURSE

- ❖ A bridge course for newly admitted UG and PG students were conducted before the commencement of the I semester classes. The main objective of the course is to bridge the gap between subjects studied at Pre-university level and subjects they would be studying in Graduation. The syllabus for the course is framed in such a way that they get basic knowledge on the subjects. A post bridge course test is conducted after the completion of bridge course syllabus to assess the ability of students. Suggestions were given to students for improvisation.

❖ The academic year 2020-2021 for the I year BSc. Psychology started on 2nd November 2020.

After the two days of HR orientation program, the department bridge course started on 4th Nov 2020 and lasted till 11th Nov 2020. The bridge courses offered were basic psychological process (core), human physiology, Psychological statistics (complementary), and the common course English. And after 7 days of coaching, a test for each subjects were conducted.

ADD-ON

The department of Psychology is providing 3 hours/ week as add on hours for each class. Each program was designed to develop the skills of the students in personal, professional and social skill. The department add on for each class was provided by the department in association with various agencies, which provides certificates for each student

❖ I BSc PSYCHOLOGY

Enneagram is a department add on course provided to the 1st year BSc Psychology students by the department of psychology in association with Institute of Counselling and Transactional Analysis (ICTA), Kochi. Enneagram is a model of the human psyche which is principally understood and taught as a typology of nine interconnected personality types. As a typology the Enneagram defines nine personality types (sometimes called "enneatypes"), which are represented by the points of a geometric figure called an enneagram, which indicate connections between the types. The main objective of this add on course was to help students to understand brief overview about Enneagram and its area of application. It was a 30 hour programme, distributed as 3 hours/ week (first three hours of every Thursday). Mr. Nelson Diaz and Mr. Sebastian Arakal from the ICTA, Kochi were faculty in charge for the programme. The program was started from 12th November 2020. The course completed on 18th March 2021. And the same agency distributed the certificate for the 43 students on April 12, 2021. It was provided for the students after evaluation of the mini project work at the end of the class.

The feedback was taken from students. They gave a satisfactory feedback about course and mentioned that it will help to understand the behavior of other person so that communication becomes effective.

❖ II BSc PSYCHOLOGY

Cognitive Behavior Therapy (CBT) is the department add on course provided to the 2nd year BSc Psychology students by the department of psychology in association with Institute of Counselling and Transactional Analysis (ICTA), Kochi. Cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT) is a common type of psychotherapy. CBT helps to become aware of inaccurate or negative thinking. So an individual can view challenging situations more clearly and respond to them in a more effective way. CBT is a useful tool to address emotional challenges. Mr. Sebastian Arakal from the same institution was the faculty in

charge for the programme. It is a 30 hour programme distributed as 3 hours/ week (first three hours of every Wednesday). The class was started on 19th August 2020. The course completed on 9th December 2020. And the same agency distributed the certificate for the 42 students on March 2021. It was provided for the students after evaluation of the mini project work at the end of the class.

The feedback was taken from students. Satisfactory report was mentioned by the students and reported that class was very helpful for them to understand cognitive behavior therapy.

❖ III BSc PSYCHOLOGY

Counselling Skills and Learning Disability is the department add on course provided to the 3rd year BSc Psychology students by the department of psychology in association with Santhwana Institute of Counselling and Psychotherapy, Kacheripady, Ernakulam . Mrs. Siji M M, from the same institution was the faculty in charge for the programme. Counselling is a helping approach that highlights the emotional and intellectual experience of a client, how a client is feeling and what they think about the problem they have sought help for. There are a number of skills that are required by counsellors. Thus the main objective of this programme was to help students to identifying and developing their basic skills for counselling. It was a 36 hour programme, distributed as 3 hours/ week (Last three hours of every Wednesday). The class was started on 19th August 2020 and course was completed on 13th January 2021. The certificate provided for 38 students after evaluating their assignment works.

❖ I MSC PSYCHOLOGY & I MSC CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY

Person Centered Therapy is the department add on course provided to the 1st year MSc Psychology and 1st year MSc Clinical Psychology students by the Department of Psychology in association with Institute of Counseling and Transactional Analysis (ICTA), Kochi. Person-centered therapy, also known as person-centered or client-centered counseling, is a humanistic approach that deals with the ways in which individuals perceive themselves consciously, rather than how a counselor can interpret their unconscious thoughts or ideas. It is a 30 hour programme distributed as 3 hours/ week (First three hours of every Thursday) Mr. Ranjith M R from the ICTA, Kochi was faculty in charge for the programme and the same agency provided the certificate for the 32 students after conducting the assignments at the end of the class. The class was started on 14th January 2021 and completed 30 hours on 29th April 2021



❖ II MSC PSYCHOLOGY & II MSC CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY

Counseling skills and Psychotherapy is the department add on course provided to the 2nd year MSc Psychology and 2nd year MSc clinical Psychology students by the department of psychology in association with Santhwana Institute of Counseling and Psychotherapy, Kacheripady, Ernakulam. Counseling & Psychotherapeutic Skills & Practice has been specifically designed for those who want to develop key foundation-level counseling skills. This is an ideal introduction to the world of counseling and psychotherapy, offering participants the opportunity to explore this growing profession. It serves as an excellent introduction to the area of counseling, and teaches general counseling skills that will benefit people in both their personal and professional lives. It is a 36 hour programme distributed as 3 hours/ week (first three hours of every Wednesday). Mrs. Siji M M was faculty in charge for the programme and the same agency provided the certificate for the 43 students after conducting the assignments at the end of the class. The class was started on 18th August 2020 and completed 30 hours on 20th January 2021.

The students expressed that they are enriched and enlightened by this course. They gave a satisfactory report about course and teacher.

❖ NET COACHING FOR PG STUDENTS

The National Eligibility Test, also known as UGC NET or NTA-UGC-NET, is the examination for determining the eligibility for the post of Assistant Professor and/or Junior Research Fellowship award in Indian universities and colleges. The department of Psychology is providing NTA NET/JRF coaching for each PG classes. The department of psychology started NET coaching class on 14th January 2021. Coaching classes are the exponential method to education that prepare students for various competitive exams and provides quality education. Group discussions and normal practice will assist the candidate to revise each subject matter thoroughly. Classes are conducted to clarify the doubts of the students regarding the topics.



INTERNAL EXAMINATIONS

First Internal Examination –Odd semester

First internal examination for III and V Semester B.Sc. Psychology and II semester M.Sc. Psychology & M.Sc. Clinical Psychology students were conducted on July 2020. Due to COVID- 19 pandemic condition exams were conducted through online mode. Department of Psychology was taken all necessary steps to face challenge posed by first online examination. For that teachers of Department was conducted a practice test for students to alleviate anxiety against online exam among students. Students were given general instruction before online exam. Online exam conducted through Linways AMS and question papers were published through assignment option. Online exam duration were 40 minutes and students directed to upload their hand written answer sheets within 10 minutes after completing exam.

First internal exam for fifth semester B.Sc. Psychology students were started on 21st July 2020 and final exams were on 27th July 2020. First internal exam for III Semester

B.Sc. Psychology students were started on 22nd July 2020. First internal exam for II semester M.Sc. psychology and M.Sc. Clinical psychology students were started on 21st July 2020 and final exam were on 27th July 2020. Department of Psychology was successfully conducted first internal exam through online mode.

First internal examination for I semester B.Sc. Psychology were conducted from 29th December 2020 to 31st December 2020. First internal examinations for first semester MSc psychology and MSc Clinical Psychology students were conducted from 18th January 2021 to 22nd January 2021

SECOND INTERNAL EXAMINATION- ODD SEMESTER

Third semester BSc Psychology second Internals were conducted from 14.10. 2020 to 16.10.2020. The V semester BSc Psychology second Internals were conducted from 19.10.2020 to 21.10.2020. Fourth semester MSc psychology and MSc clinical psychology, second Internals were conducted from 14-10-2020-17-10-2020.

Second internal examination for I semester of B.Sc Psychology were conducted from 22nd February 2021. Second internal examinations for I semester MSc Psychology and MSc Clinical Psychology students were conducted from 22nd March 2021 to 26th March 2021

First internal examination for IV and VI semester of B.Sc. Psychology were conducted from 29th December 2020 to 31st December 2020. Practical model examination for third year B Sc psychology students were conducted on 6th January 2021.

First internal examinations for IV Semester MSc psychology and MSc Clinical Psychology students were conducted from 12th January 2021 to 14th January 2021.

Second internal examination for IV and VI Semester B.Sc Psychology students were conducted from 22nd February 2021

REMEDIAL CLASSES

Remedial classes were given to the weaker students according to their performance in the class as well as in exams. Through sessions teachers give proper instructions which help them to improve their academic excellence.

The Department of psychology conducted remedial classes for V Semester B.Sc Psychology students (2018 admission onwards). The students were selected as per their performance in internal exams.

Alina Thomas, Siniya joy, Akshay mohan, Anand G, Rejoice Byju, Prince Paul, Pranav Sashi Nair and Joel John were the students selected from final year class. They attended remedial classes for each core subjects. Those classes were handled by Dr. Sr. Karunya (Abnormal Psychology I), Dr. Sr. Jessy George (Developmental Psychology), Anna Pheenix T S (Health Psychology) and Malavika.T.P (Psychological Counselling & Social Psychology).

U G - PROJECT

Pursuing a research project enables students to pursue an original study about a topic of interest. 38 students conducted a small project on psychologically and socially relevant topics. The project work started from the V semester under the supervision of guides and completed the report at the end of VI Semester. Data collection was done through Google form. Students did the project work individually and submitted the report in manuscript format (handwritten form) before 5th March 2020.

P G – DISSERTATION

Dissertation is a minor level research in behavior, mainly intended to train in research methodology, logical thinking and report writing. 21 students of M.Sc. Psychology and 22 students of M.Sc. Clinical Psychology students were conducted research on psychologically and socially relevant topics. The project work started from the III Semester under the supervision of guides and completed the report at the end of IV semester. Data collection was done through Google form. Students did the project work individually and submitted the report on 31st May 2021.

PG- PRACTICUM/INTERNSHIP

Psychology internship training program emphasizes evidence-based care and recognizes the importance of clinical science training and practice. Internship represents the capstone of a new psychologist's formal academic training and induction into the profession. IV semester M Sc Psychology and M.Sc. Clinical Psychology students went for internship on 15th February 2021. On 22nd March, students were back to the campus after the internship. Students submitted their internship report based on their experiences during the training day.

ABILITY ENHANCEMENT COURSE

Ability enhancement course is an audit course where the student may seek support of faculty members where - as there may not be regular classes on it. The guidance can be received from the department to proceed the work. The performance will be evaluated in college level. For I and II semester B.Sc. Psychology students the audit course were Environment studies and Disaster management. End semester exams were conducted.

For MSc Clinical Psychology and MSc Psychology the suggested audit course is Community Extension Work and life skill training. Students from both PG Classes were conducted a brief survey to understand the need of Psychological services in their neighboring community during the COVID 19 epoch. The work was done by students in holidays and report was submitted as well as briefly presented in the department.

PTA MEETINGS

The Parent Teachers Meetings were conducted on 13th August 2020 for parents of B.Sc. Psychology students and on 24th August 2020 for M.Sc. students through Google Meet. It was organized to evaluate online classes, attendance, and internal exam result and to discuss student's progress and performance at this semester. Due to the pandemic outbreak in our society it was difficult to meet parents directly; hence the meeting was conducted through the virtual platform Google Meet. The link was sent to the parents and was invited to be present by the time.

The Parent Teachers Meeting for III and V Semester B.Sc. Psychology students of the academic year 2020-2021 was held on 13th August 2020 at 11.30 am to 12.45 pm & 1.45 pm to 2.50 pm respectively. The Parent Teachers Meeting for III semester M.Sc. Psychology & M.Sc. Clinical Psychology students of the academic year 2020-2021 was held on 24th August 2020 at 1.45 pm to 2.50 pm through Google Meet.

The parent-teachers meeting of I semester B. 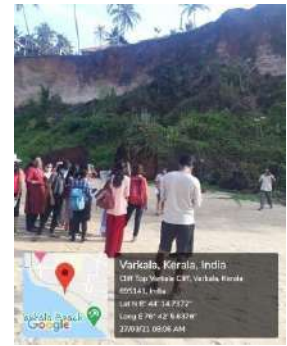
FIELD WORK FOR 3rd YEAR GEOLOGY STUDENTS AT KERALA
