Lazar Kuttikkadan (President, IDET& Manager, Sahridaya Group of Institutions), inaugurated by Dr. Zakir Husain (Dean of Physical Education, Calicut University) and lighting of the lamp was done by Sri. C.V.Sunny(Internaional Basket ball player and Indian captain/Indian team coach). After the formal function, a friendly shoot out competition between our college boys and girls basket ball team. A friendly Basket Ball between Sree Kerala Varma College ,Thrissur and Sacred Heart College Thevara was organized to mark the occasion. The match was won by Sree Kerala Varma College ,Thrissur. Students are given in-house training in various sports events from the beginning and participation in championships ensured.

ISO CERTIFICATION PROCESS

Sahridaya College of Advanced Studies aspired to be an ISO certified institution at the 6th year of its functioning as an Arts and Science College. A committee was constituted to spearhead the activities on a war footage, with Prof. K J Davis as its Chief Co-ordinator (CCO) and Ms. Annie faith as the Deputy Co-ordinator(DCCO) along with 13 internal auditors from various departments . The members of the committee included representatives from each department.

The first meeting of the committee was held in August 2017 and Prof. K J Davis explained the primary steps to be taken to systematize the filing pattern of various departments. Our consultants, Mr. Kiran and team visited each departments and collected lists of files maintained in each department. They categorized them under various titles, and monitored the labeling of files in a uniform pattern. Reference numbers were given to files so that identification of files and documentation of details under each title become easy. Staff representatives monitored and ensured the process and its completion in their assigned departments.

Once the filing, labeling processes got over, the consultants re-checked the arrangements and suggested changes and improvements were executed meticulously. The first Management review meeting was conducted on 22.02.2018. The external audit team, QMPG – Industrial & Certification Service, Kochi -38 visited the college for the first External Audit in February, 2018. On the basis of the audit findings, corrective measures were taken and by 19th February 2018, the college was ready for its Final External Audit prior to ISO Certification. On 17th March, 2018 the final audit was conducted by QMPG. On finding the college complying with the regulatory and statutory requirements of ISO 9001: 2015, the college was recommended for ISO Certification. ISO 2009: 2015 awarded by DAS Certification UK wide Certification No. DAS 40384631/ 47/Q dated 15.05.2018.

SAHRDAYA SATHVOTSAV 2019 (16th February – 23rd February)

“Sahrdaya Sathvotsav” was a weeklong All India Inter University Power Lifting Championship organized in collaboration with University of Calicut. SCAS is the second individual institution to organize an interuniversity championship hosted by the University. The organizing committee office was inaugurated by Mr. B D Devassy Chalakudy MLA in presence of Dr. Sakeer Hussain V P , Director of Physical Education, University of Calicut , Executive Director Rev. Fr. Titus Kattuparambil , Principal Dr. P O Jenson and other invited guests. Logo of the championship designed by Asst. Professor Mr. Renjith M was released by former District Judge Mr. D Ravindrababu on 13th January 2019 in presence of Executive Director Rev. Fr. Titus Kattuparambil & Associate Executive Director Rev. Dr. Devis Chenginiyadan . Power lifting has been a paralympic sport since 1984 and under the IPF (International Power lifting Federation). It is also a world sport. Power lifting tends to attract determined individuals. It is a wonderful sport and a true test of strength, heart and courage.

Sahrdaya College of Advanced Studies believes in team work to succeed in all endeavours. Power of energy was ushered in through several steps, several procedures, and several days. Staff and students of the college worked together as a single unit under the guidance of Patrons, University Officials, Technical officials and well wishers. Registration to the championship (Men & Women) was taken by University of Calicut and was forwarded to the Physical Education Department of the college from time to time. The department prepared the list of participants and was handed over to all committee convenors. Apart from the organizing committee, there are 15 other committees formed with a chairman at the helm of each. Staff and students were inducted into each committee. Convenor of the committee was chosen among the staff of the college. All committees had a student coordinator.

Reception committee was entrusted the task of receiving the participants, officials and delegates at the railway station. For the purpose a pavilion was set up at Thrissur railway station from 16th February onwards. The pavilion was manned by one staff member and 2 students at a time on shift basis. They were directed to the bus facility arranged by the Transportation committee and upon arrival at the venue guidance was given to complete the registration procedure. The participants were provided with a Sahrdayan kit comprising championship schedule , guidelines of conduct , floor map of the venue and a memento. Transportation committee had the responsibility of arranging conveyance at regular intervals to and from the venue which also happens to be the place of accommodation provided to participants. The committee also arranged conveyance for officials who were provided accommodation at PACS, Kallettumkara. Food & Accommodation committee had the huge responsibility

providing the aforementioned both to 176 women participants from 51 universities and 373 men participants from 83 universities during the respective championships. Separate accommodation arrangements were done for participants and officials. Food arrangement was also done separate for volunteers, officials of organizing committee, convenors of various committees and other supporters of the programme.

Finance committee met well wishers and potential sponsors to generate additional revenue for organizing the championship. Teams remitted Rs. 2000 as registration fee , which formed the primary revenue to meet the expenses.

Technical Committee handled all technical aspects of the championship. Eligibility, Records and scrutiny committee verified the documents related to eligibility and those found not eligible were disqualified during scrutiny itself. Stage, Ground & Equipment committee made available facility for setting up the stage and coordinating the availability of the equipments for each event of the championship. Refreshment committee provided food & refreshment to loaders without any impediments. Media & Publicity committee ensured coverage of the championship by all media. They also arranged for banners , shields and flex to be installed at various locations for publicity. Walkathon , bike rally & flash mob were arranged as promotional events. Medical Committee arranged the service of an orthopaedic surgeon and 2 nurses from St. James Hospital, Chalakudy on all days from 9.00 a.m – 6.00 p.m. Programme committee organized inaugural & valedictory ceremonies separately for Women & men championships and also cultural evenings. Medal committee was responsible for organizing medal ceremonies upon completion of each class of competition. Medal ceremonies at Sahrdaya Sathvotsav were filled with richness of Kerala heritage. Women winners were given apart from their respective medals, a hand painted (kathakali face) kerala traditional shawl & miniature replica of traditional snake boat (chundanvallom) each. The shawls were designed by students of the college, who were glad to take up the responsibility. Men winners were presented with a decorative head gear made out of traditional kerala fabric and miniature replica of traditional snake boat each. The head gears were designed and made by staff members of the college who were assigned the pleasant task. The boats were made of wood & brass. Eminent personalities and Sathvotsav sponsors were among the invited guests at the 15 medal ceremonies throughout the championship.
