DEPARTMENT WISE PROGRAMME REPORT IN DETAIL

English Department

The academic year 2019-20 began in June with the second year BA, the third year BA and second year MA English students beginning regular classes. On completion of the admission process, the first year BA English and first year MA English classes began in July.

In order to bring students coming from varied educational background at par in English, a Bridge Course in English was given to students irrespective of the department enrolled to alongwith first year BA English students too. A subject specific Bridge Course was also given to first year BA English so as to acquaint them with the course enrolled to.

First and Second Internal Exam for the Odd Semesters was conducted for both the UG and the PG students. Besides assignments and seminar reports were submitted by the students. Seminars were presented by the students in class using varied methods including power point presentation. The First internal exam in the Even semester was conducted in the month of January while the Second internal was to be conducted in March but was stalled because of COVID'19 lockdown. However, online tests by respective teachers were administered from the confines of their homes. Assignments, seminar reports and the presentations were done by the students before the lockdown.

Projects of third year BA English students were completed under the able guidance of their teachers.

The external final Viva Voce was conducted in March 2020. The Project Viva Voce for second year MA English students is yet to be conducted.

With the syllabus revision in the first year PG and UG Courses, Audit Courses have been included.

The first semester Audit Course Exam on Environmental Studies was conducted with a cent percent result. First year PG students wrote papers on their Audit Course Writing Skills and were accordingly graded.

English department offers Film Studies as an Open Course. The students from departments other than English are offered the course. Fifth Semester Exam for the Open Course was conducted.

In order to equip the students with skills necessary for the industry and for further studies, an Add On Course on Preliminary English Test by Cambridge Assessment English was given to the students of the English Department by an external faculty. The exams were also conducted in the month of January with successful results declared in the month of February.

Besides, our PG students earned commendable distinction by presenting papers at various colleges and getting them published thereby developing their insights on the subject.

Thus English Department made efforts to execute the plan prepared at the beginning of the year as well as during the year to capacitate the students in coming out with flying colours.

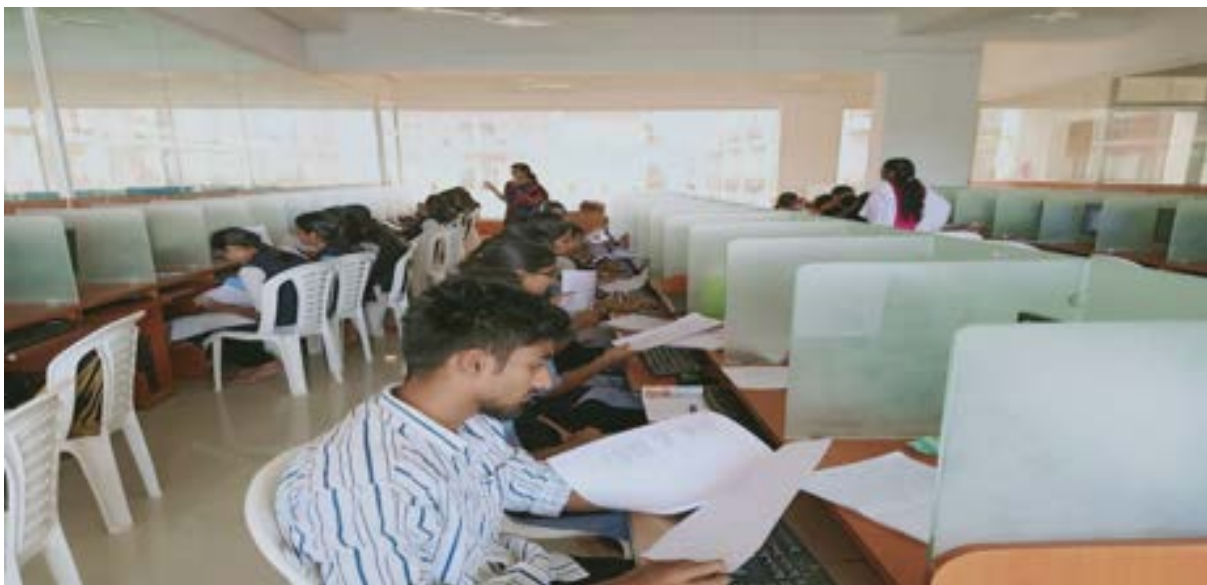
Study Trip

II BSc PSYCHOLOGY

Counselling skills is the department add on course provided to the second year BSc Psychology students by the department of psychology in association with **Institute of Counselling and Transactional Analysis**

(ICTA), Kochi. Counselling is a helping approach that highlights the emotional and intellectual experience of a client, how a client is feeling and what they think about the problem they have sought help for. There are a number of skills *that* are required by counsellors. Thus the main objective of this programme was to help students to identifying and developing their basic skills for counselling. It is a 30 hour programme distributed as 3 hours/ week (first three hours of every Thursday). Fr. Wilson Mulakal S J from the ICTA, Kochi was faculty in charge for the programme. And the same agency will be providing the certificate for the 38 students after conducting the examinations at the end of the class. The class was started on 12 December 2019. The course completed on 5th March 2020. And the same agency distributed the certificate for the 38 students. It was provided for the students after evaluation of the Assignment work at the end of the class.

The feedback was taken from students. Satisfactory report was mentioned by the students and reported that class was very helpful for them to understand counselling processes and counselling skills.

III BSc PSYCHOLOGY

CBT- Cognitive Behaviour Therapy is the department add on course provided to the third year BSc Psychology students by the department of psychology in association with **Institute of Counselling and Transactional Analysis (ICTA), Kochi.** Cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT) is a common type of talk therapy (psychotherapy). CBT helps become aware of inaccurate or

negative thinking so you can view challenging situations more clearly and respond to them in a more effective way. CBT is a useful tool to address emotional challenges. Dr. Assissi Menachery from the same institution was the faculty in charge for the programme. It was a 40 hour programme, distributed as 3 hours/ week (first three hours of every Wednesday). The class was started on 21 August 2019. But it was dropped by faculty after completing 24 hours. The certificate provided for 38 students by ICTA, Kochi after evaluating their assignment works. The feedback for completed classes obtained from students were satisfactory.

I MSC PSYCHOLOGY & I MSC CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY

CBT- Cognitive Behaviour Therapy is the department add on course provided to the first year MSc Psychology and first year MSc clinical Psychology students by the department of psychology in association with **Institute of Counselling and Transactional Analysis (ICTA), Kochi**. CBT builds a set of skills that enables an individual to be aware of thoughts and emotions; identify how situations, thoughts, and behaviors influence emotions; and improve feelings by changing dysfunctional thoughts and behaviors. It is a 30 hour programme distributed as 3 hours/ week (last three hours of every Thursday). Mr. Sebastian Arakkal from the ICTA, Kochi was faculty in charge for the programme. And the same agency provided the certificate for the 43 students after conducting the assignments at the end of the class. The class was started on 23 January 2020 and completed 18 hours. The feedback was taken from students, they expressed that it was helpful for them to understand the importance of reconstructing negative thoughts for modifying dysfunctional thoughts and behaviours.

II MSC PSYCHOLOGY & II MSC CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY

Family counselling is the department add on course provided to the first year MSc Psychology and second year MSc clinical Psychology students by the department of psychology in association with **Institute of Counselling and Transactional Analysis (ICTA), Kochi**. Family counseling is a program of providing information and professional guidance to members of a family concerning specific health matters, such as the care of a severely retarded child or the risk of transmitting a known genetic defect. The main objectives of the course are Describe the process of family counseling in terms of laying down its aims and objectives, process of assessment and the intervention process in

family counseling; Describe the indications and contraindications for applying family counseling; and Critically analyses or evaluate the entire family counseling process. It is a 30 hour programme distributed as 3 hours/ week (last three hours of every Thursday). Fr. Wilson Mulakal from the ICTA, Kochi was faculty in charge for the programme.
