




Day 5


DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY


DEPARTMENT OF FRENCH







BICYCLE DAY




WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY









TREASURE HUNT

CA TALKS






MULTIPLE SKILL CONTEST


STUDENT COUNCIL


