#### REMEDIAL CLASSES

## **VALUE EDUCATION**


## DEPARTMENT WISE ACTIVITY REPORTS IN DETAIL







#### RISORGIMENTO: AUDIOBOOK RELEASE



#### **Talk on Fundamentals of Project Writing**






#### **Faculty Exchange Programme 2021-22**


#### STUDENT-TEACHER INITIATIVE 2021 – INAUGURAL SESSION




#### 3rd SEMESTER MA ENGLISH PTA MEETING 2021-22




#### NATIONAL WEBINAR ON MEDICAL HUMANITIES, 2021-22




#### STUDENT TEACHER INIATIVE- SESSION 1


# DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

The session concluded with a vote of thanks by Ms Kavya M R (Asst. Professor). Asif Mohammed compered the entire session.






