He started the sessions with the activities to show the reluctance of students to come forward and discussed various entrepreneurial activities, patents and the details of the incubation programmes conducted at his college.

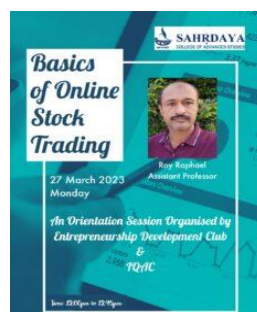

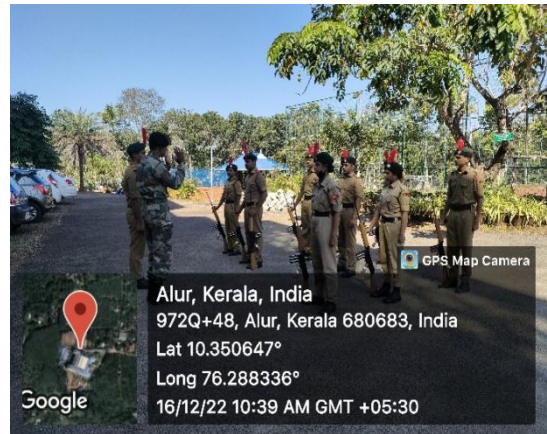
The training sessions focused on improving their physical endurance, military knowledge, and teamwork abilities.

The speaking test started at 10 am and ended at 4 pm on both days. 16 candidates were marked absent for the speaking examination. There were 3 invigilators and 2 speaking examiners per session on the scheduled dates.

On 8th June 2023, the SLRW tests of B2 FCE were scheduled for 12 candidates. The exam was conducted for an external candidate and BA English students of 2022 admission under the supervision of Centre Exams Manager, Ms. Asha Sudheesh. The Speaking Test and the LRW were on the same day. The students were given the hall tickets and their IDs were crosschecked at the waiting room numbered 230, second floor PG block. After taking the candidates' test day photos, they were sent to lab 1 on the same floor. The LRW exam commenced at 10.00 am and ended by 1.30 pm. One candidate was marked absent for the LRW.

The speaking test started at 2.30 pm and ended at 4.00 pm with required break sessions. The candidates were assembled in the waiting room numbered 225 where their IDs were crosschecked. The test was conducted in room number 226 with 2 speaking examiners for the session. A buffer room numbered 230 was arranged for students done with their exams to avoid interaction with the candidates who have not taken their tests. There were no absentees for the speaking component.

On 12th May 2023, the SLRW Tests of PET for Schools were scheduled for 8 candidates, under the supervision of Centre Exams Manager, Ms. Asha Sudheesh. The exam was conducted for BA Malayalam students of 2022 admission. It was concluded on the same day by using both the morning as well as afternoon sessions. The students were given the hall tickets and their IDs were crosschecked at the waiting room numbered 225 on the second floor and they were sent to lab 1 on the same floor. The LRW test commenced by 10.00 am and ended by 12.35 pm. The speaking component started at 2.00 pm and ended at 3.30 pm with adequate break sessions.

Cambridge Centre's annual certification ceremony of the speaking examiners was conducted on January 28th 2023. The recertification procedure was done by Mr. Rakesh Ramachandran, TL Cambridge Assessment English. The session started at 9.30 am in the AV room. Executive Director, Dr. Fr. Devis Chenginiyadan inaugurated the session. Centre Exam Manager, Ms Asha Sudheesh was present during the procedure. 8 speaking examiners participated in the ceremony and the programme concluded at 1.00pm.

The SLRW components of B1 Business Preliminary of Cambridge Assessment English were scheduled for 357 candidates on 9,12,13 and 16th of June 2023. The exam was conducted for first-year B. Com students' of 2022 admission, under the supervision of the Centre Exams Manager, Ms. Asha Sudheesh. The Speaking Tests were conducted during AM and PM sessions on 9,12 and 13th of June 2023. The Speaking tests took place in rooms 134,135 and 136 on the first floor of the admin block. The students were confirmed entries and their IDs were crosschecked in the waiting room numbered 127. The students were sent back to their respective classrooms to avoid interaction with the candidates who have not

taken their tests. The speaking test started by 10 am and ended by 4 pm on each day except on the 9th Friday when it got concluded at 4.30 pm. 13 candidates were marked absent for the speaking examination. There were 5 invigilators and 6 speaking examiners per session on the scheduled dates. The LRW Test was held on 16th June 2023.

It was conducted in 3 Cohorts (AM cohort 1 and PM cohort 1&2) for 357 candidates in total, starting from 10.00 am and ending at 6.30 pm. The duration for each cohort was 2.30hrs approx. The timings of the exam for cohorts 1,2 and 3 were from 10.00 am to 12.30 pm, 1.00 pm .to 3.30 pm, and 4.00 pm to 6.30 pm respectively. Cohort one and two had 120 candidates each and Cohort 3 had 119 candidates in total. Candidates were arranged in 3 labs named Lab N1, Lab 1, and Lab 3 with 2 invigilators in each lab.

The SLRW components of B1 Business Preliminary of Cambridge Assessment English were scheduled for 181 candidates on 2, 3, and 6th of May 2023. The exam was conducted for UG first-year Arts & Science students of 2022 admission (English, Physics, Chemistry, Geology, Maths, Psychology, Computer Science, BCA) excluding the BA Malayalam batch under the supervision of the Centre Exams Manager, Ms. Asha Sudheesh. The Speaking Tests were conducted during AM and PM sessions on the 2nd & 3rd of May 2023. The Speaking tests took place in rooms 226, 227, and 228 on the second floor of the PG block. The students were confirmed entries and their IDs were crosschecked at the waiting room numbered 225. The students were sent to Buffer room numbered 230 to avoid interaction with the candidates who have not taken their tests. The speaking test started by 10 am and ended by 1 pm for the AM session and the PM session started by 2 pm and ended by 4 pm on the first day. On the second day, the exam was only during the AM session and followed the same schedule as day one. 20 candidates were marked absent for the speaking examination. There were 7 invigilators and 6 speaking examiners per session on the scheduled dates.

The LRW Test was held on 6th May 2023. It was conducted in 2 Cohorts for 181 candidates in total, starting from 10.00 am to 12.30 pm and 2.00 pm to 4.30 pm. The duration for each cohort was 2.30hrs approx. Candidates were arranged in 3 labs named Lab 1, Lab 2, and Lab 3 with 2 invigilators in each lab. There were 21 absentees for the LRW Test.

As a follow up to the Kinder Lingua summer camp conducted from May 4th to May 20th 2022, Cambridge's YLE Exam was given to the participants of the camp. Exams for both A1 and A2 level was given on October 15th 2022, Saturday. A total of 15 students registered for the exam, out of which 2 were absent on that day. Altogether 13 students attempted the exam and among them 8 candidates took A2 level (Flyers) and 5 took A1 level (Movers) exam.

A WhatsApp group for parents of Kinder Lingua was maintained and for information regarding the exams was posted on this. Parents were given clear instructions on exam format, venue, time and duration and stationery required. YLE Exam sample question papers and speaking test videos for both A1 and A2 were uploaded in the group.

The mode of exam was paper based and Listening test started at 10.00 am for both Movers and Flyers. The duration of exams were 25 minutes and got concluded at 10.25 am. 20 minutes break was provided to the students and LRW for both Movers and Flyers started at 10.45 am. The duration for LRW test for Movers was for 30 minutes and the exam got over by 11.15. The duration for LRW test for Flyers was for 40 minutes and the exam got over by 11.25. After the lunch break the speaking exam commenced at 1.00pm for both A1 and A2 level. Mr Rakesh Ramachandran was the speaking examiner for both the levels. The Speaking test got successfully concluded at 2.00pm.

A total of 9 students engaged in the outreach Programme showing their active participation by conducting games, activities, worksheet learning and followed

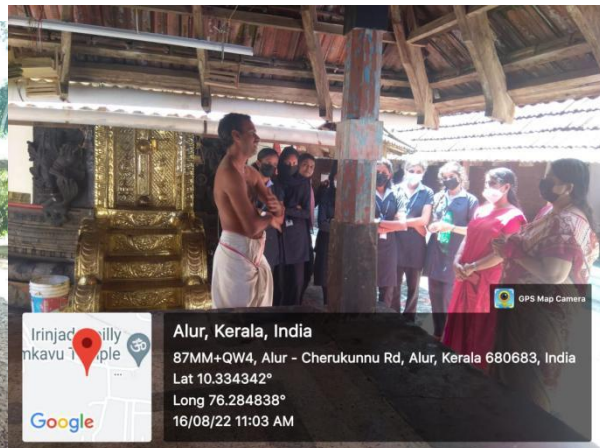
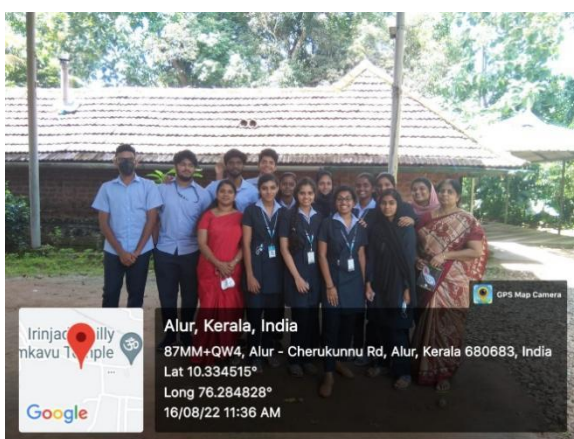
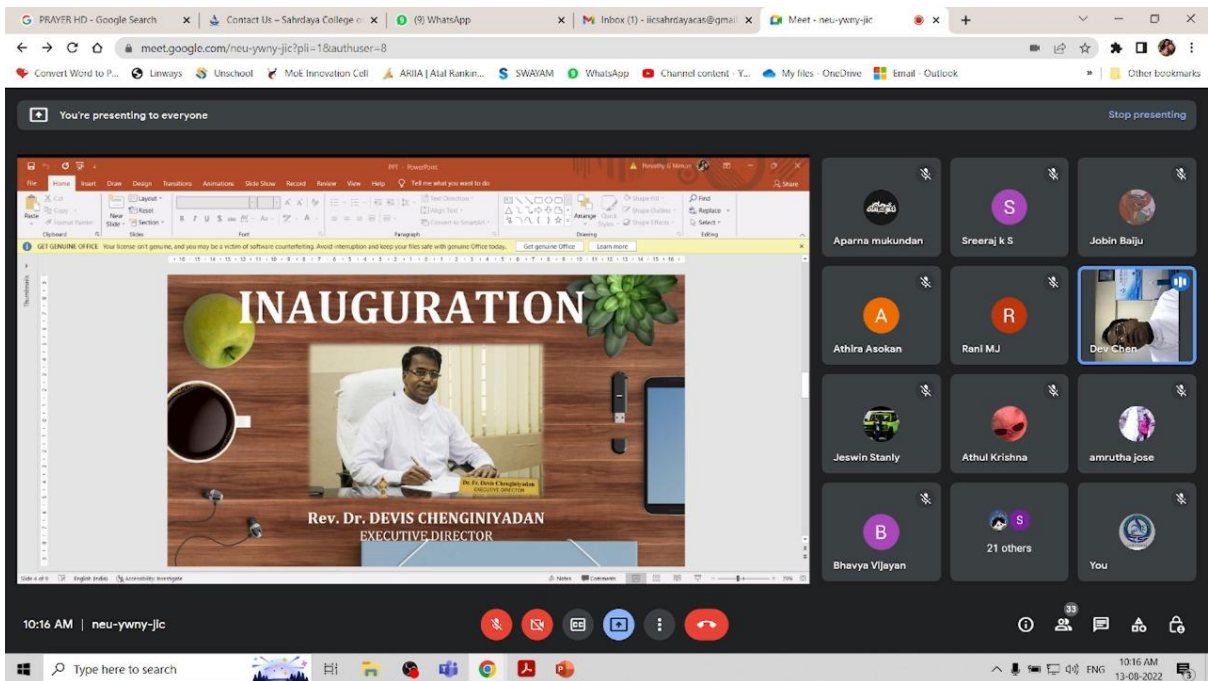
by tricks and tips in Mathematics. The classes were winded off by 12.30 p.m. and the students returned to the college with great experience.

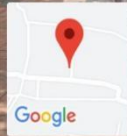
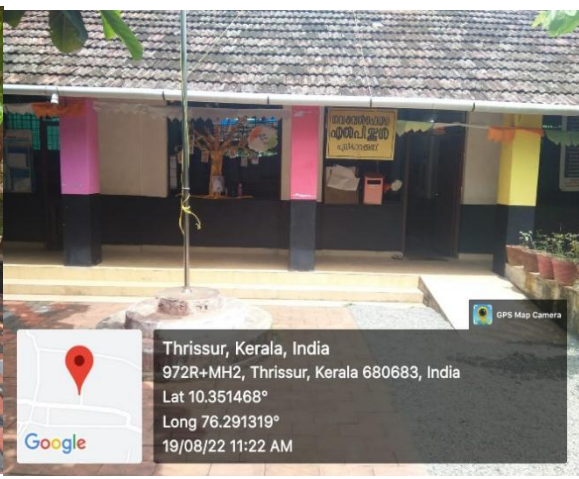

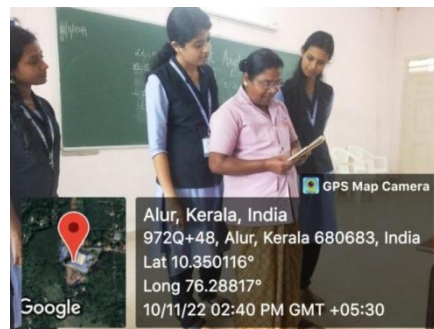
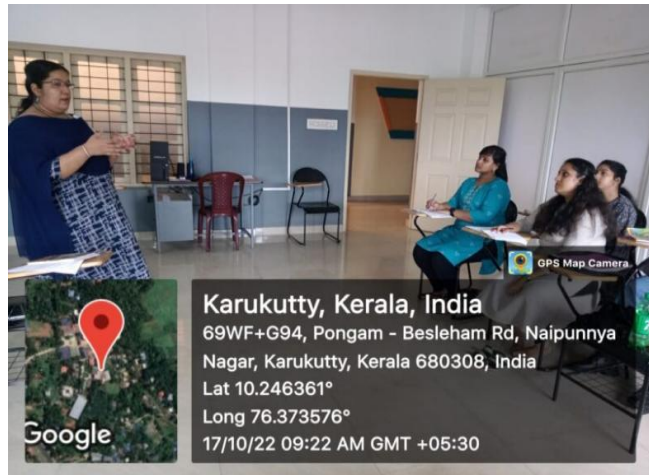
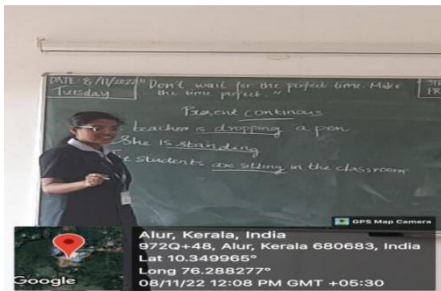
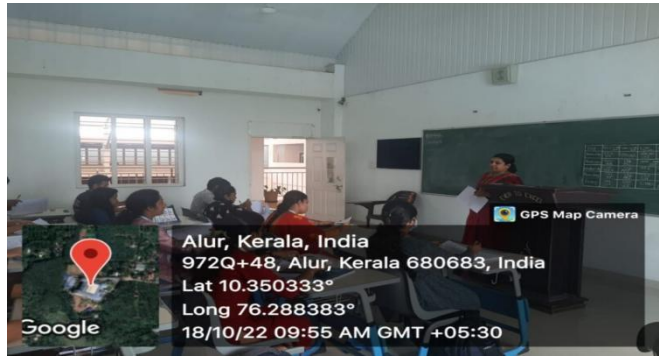
The Post Graduate Department of English conducted the Student-Teacher Initiative for the academic year 2022-23 on 24th March 2023.
