




2. STUDENT CENTRIC LEARNING METHODS




GROUP DISCUSSION ON NEP 2020






FIELD VISIT TO INCUBATION CENTRE








SKILLS FOR ENTREPRENEURS







FRIDAY MARKET


As part of Onam 2k22, Onam expo was conducted on 31st August 2022 in the college where the members of the ED club sold different items like chips to the students and Faculty members.












BASIS OF ONLINE STOCK TRADING







1.CONSTITUTION RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS 2.EXTENSION AND OUTREACH ACTIVITIES


